

Terms and Conditions Contest “Ice Hockey World Championship 2026 – Ticket Giveaway”

GENERAL

“Ice Hockey World Championship 2026 – Ticket Giveaway” (hereinafter the “Contest”) is a promotional competition organized by Swisslos Interkantonale Landeslotterie. Participation is possible electronically and without any purchase obligation during the period from 20 March 2026 to 4 May 2026. Among all participants, tickets for games of the 2026 IIHF Ice Hockey World Championship in Zurich will be raffled.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participation is open to all natural persons aged 18 years or older with residence in the Swisslos territory (Cantons AI, AG, AR, BE, BL, BS, GL, GR, LU, NW, OW, SG, SH, SO, SZ, TI, TG, UR, ZG, ZH and the Principality of Liechtenstein).
2. Each person may participate in the Contest only once.
3. Employees of Swisslos, employees of agencies or partner companies involved in the organization of the Contest, and their family members living in the same household are excluded from participation.
4. Participation using temporary or fictitious email addresses, scripts, automated entry services or similar methods is strictly prohibited and may result in legal action.

PARTICIPATION

5. To participate in the Contest, participants must place virtual pucks on the game(s) of the 2026 Ice Hockey World Championship in Zurich they would like to attend via the competition platform and confirm their selection. Each puck increases the chance of winning 1 × 2 tickets for the respective game. Each participant may place a maximum of three (3) virtual pucks per day. The pucks may be distributed across one (1), two (2), or three (3) games.
6. The email address must be confirmed via double opt-in. Participation on subsequent days is possible using the same email address. If the browser does not recognize a participant via cookies, participation must be confirmed using a magic link sent by email.
7. One winner will be drawn for each game at the end of the contest period.
8. Every valid participation in accordance with section 5 automatically enters the draw. Participation will be considered for the games on which pucks have been placed. Once a participant has been drawn as a winner, they are excluded from further draws, as a maximum of 1 × 2 tickets per person may be awarded.

CONTEST PROCEDURE

- Contest can only be played online via the microsite hockeytickets.swisslos.ch. Participants must register using their email address and additional information (first name, last name, postal code) and confirm that they are of legal age.

PRIZES

The following prizes can be won:

- Tickets for games of the 2026 Ice Hockey World Championship in Zurich. A maximum of 2 × 2 tickets per game in Zurich will be raffled.
- Each person may win a maximum of one prize consisting of 1 × 2 tickets.
- The prizes will be randomly drawn among all eligible participants on 5 May 2026. Winners will be notified by email after the draw and must confirm acceptance of the prize within the specified deadline; otherwise, the entitlement to the tickets expires. Tickets will be handed over exclusively on-site at the Sporttip stand in Zurich. Swisslos reserves the right to verify the winner's legal age. Tickets must be collected no later than 30 minutes before the start of the game. If a winner fails to appear in time, the entitlement to the tickets expires without compensation. In such a case, Swisslos reserves the right to reassign the tickets on site.
- Swisslos is responsible for organizing the Contest. All decisions relating to the conduct of the draw will be made in consultation with the Swisslos representatives present. These decisions, as well as the results of the draw, are final.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Cash payment of prizes is excluded. Swisslos reserves the right to replace an advertised prize with another prize of equivalent value. Tickets are non-transferable where required due to organizer regulations, ticket conditions, or organizational reasons.
- Participants who violate these Terms and Conditions and/or attempt to manipulate the Contest may be excluded. In such cases, rankings may be corrected, prizes may be revoked (even retroactively), or prizes already paid out or delivered may be reclaimed.
- Swisslos as the organizer, as well as the agencies or partners involved in organizing the Contest, reserve the right to terminate, cancel, or suspend the Contest if proper execution can no longer be guaranteed, particularly in cases of hardware or software failure, program errors, computer viruses, unauthorized third-party interference, or mechanical, technical, or legal issues.
- Swisslos endeavors to ensure that the Contest can be played on all common web browsers or their current versions. If a browser or browser version is not supported, no entitlement to participate in the Contest arises.

18. If emails cannot be delivered to winners (e.g., due to technical problems), no claim to compensation exists.
19. Participants also agree that Swisslos may inform them about additional lottery and betting offers. Under no circumstances will personal data be shared with third parties. This consent can be revoked at any time by unsubscribing.
20. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the Contest. Legal recourse is excluded. In the event of discrepancies between the French, English, Italian, and German versions of these Terms and Conditions, the German version shall prevail.
